



MPS Dress Code

Purpose: The dress code is implemented to uphold a professional standard.

Expectations: The dress code is required during scheduled academic class time and academic/professional events hosted by University/College or student organizations.

Violation of the Dress Code: Students will be given warnings and asked to change into proper attire.

Students are permitted to wear:

- Polo style shirts, dress shirts, or sweater, blouses, collared shirts
- Slacks, dress style pants, khaki pants, jeans
- Conservative skirt or dress

Students are NOT permitted to wear:

- Sweatpants, shorts, short skirts or dresses
- T-shirts, mid-riffs, tank tops
- Revealing clothing
- Flip flops
- Hats (with exception of religious or certain medical conditions)

Additional Dress Code Information:

- No visible tattoos or body piercings (conservative earrings and piercings are allowed)
- No excessive fading, rips, holes or tears
- Spirit Day Wednesday!

Both students and staff are allowed a more casual look while wearing CNU or MPS apparel, demonstrating the university's pride spirit.
